Dr. Paula Englis introduced the proposals for the CSOB for vote:

- Proposal: Change catalog language for the MBA program to replace the subsection "Goals of the M.B.A. Program" with new language under the title of "MBA Student Learning Outcomes" see accompanying submission or details.
- Proposal: Change the Master of Business Administration major. Remove the following courses from the list of elective course options: BUS 674, FIN 631, MGT 606, MKT 610. Change respective catalog language for elective requirements.
- Proposal: Change catalog language under the section "Students may take either of the courses listed below as part of the Required Courses." Under the listed courses, add: "Students who complete both courses will be allowed to count one of the courses as an elective."
- Proposal: Change catalog language relating to MBA admissions policy. Replace the following:
 "Applicants who have earned a graduate degree from a fully accredited institution of higher
 education are eligible for admission without submission of GMAT or GRE scores." See attached
